Listed below are 3 scholarships. Please read through the criteria carefully and discuss with your counselor the ones that you meet the requirements. After completing the attached application, please have your counselor sign the application. You will be considered for the scholarships that you have indicated on this sheet. Please *mark clearly* the scholarships that you are applying for.

QHS Class of 1957 Scholarship--\$2,500

This scholarship commemorates the 50th Reunion of the QHS Class of 1957. The purpose of this scholarship is to express appreciation to parents, teachers, and citizens of Quincy who gave this class an excellent education, to honor and remember classmates of the Class of 1957 and their many contributions to society, and to encourage the youth of today and tomorrow to make the most of their lives through education and service to others.

Eligibility Criteria and Guidelines:

- Students must be a graduate of Quincy Senior High School
- Students must attend a four-year, degree granting, accredited institution full time.
- ***This scholarship is NOT based on financial need—please disregard income section of attached application for this particular scholarship.***
- A 500 words or less typed essay must be attached to application.
- The topic of the essay is as follows: “Why are you a good candidate to receive this award? Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability both in and out of school. Where do you see yourself ten years from now?”
- Community or volunteer service is desirable but not required.
- Student must demonstrate involvement in extra curricular activities
- This is a merit based scholarship
- **Minimum high school GPA of 3.5 is required.**
- Job or volunteer history is required.
- Two letters of recommendation are required.
- The deadline for this scholarship is **March 1, 2017**



THE BECKY SWISHER CROWE
MEMORIALSCHOLARSHIP- \$1,000

This scholarship was established in memory of Becky Swisher Crowe who taught in the Quincy Public Schools from 1970-1979. Becky was killed in an automobile accident on her way to school the morning of March 9, 1979. She taught at both Quincy Junior High School and Quincy Senior High School.

Eligibility Criteria and Guidelines:

- The primary purpose of the fund is to provide one scholarship at an accredited two-year, four-year or community college for tuition, room and board, fees and/or books and related expenses for a Quincy Senior High graduating senior who intends to **pursue a career in education**.
- This scholarship is based on:
 - Financial need
 - Intend to pursue Education as a course of study
 - **Minimum GPA of 3.0**
- Two letters of recommendation from adults who know the candidate well are required.
- Applicant must be of good character and display good citizenship.
- Essay: Minimum of 200 words (typewritten and attached to scholarship application) with:
 - Why he or she is choosing the field of education
 - Any unique experiences that would support a career in education
 - A statement of future goals
 - Any special qualities applicant possesses
- Please attach a copy of a seventh semester transcript
- Please attach a copy of current class schedule
- The deadline for this scholarship is **March 24, 2017**



THE KENNETH AND ELEANOR LOHR
MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND-\$770

The daughters of Kenneth and Eleanor Lohr established the fund with the Community Foundation to honor their parents' passion and life working in the pharmaceutical profession. Mr. Lohr encouraged young people to pursue the pharmaceutical profession.

Eligibility Criteria and Guidelines:

- The primary purpose of the fund is to provide a scholarship to a graduate of Quincy Senior High intending to enter the field of or majoring in **pharmacy**. The scholarship can be used for tuition, room and board, fees and/or books, and related expenses.
- FAFSA documents are required.
- This scholarship is based on:
 - Being a graduate of QHS
 - Intent to pursue a degree in Pharmacy
 - FAFSA documents
- An essay of 500 words or less is required. Topic: "Why I want to be a pharmacist OR what prompted me to pursue pharmacy." Attach typewritten essay to scholarship application.
- The deadline for this scholarship is **March 24, 2017**
