

Eligibility/Criteria

The *Baxter Memorial Scholarship* awarded annually to a high school senior residing or attending school within the counties of Adams, Brown, Hancock, McDonough, Pike, or Schuyler in Illinois who will attend an ABET-accredited engineering or technical program at a four-year college or university.

The scholarship is award is up to a maximum of \$1,000. More than one applicant may be chosen to receive the scholarship.

A. Eligibility Requirements

Applicant must be a high school senior who:

- will attend an ABET-accredited engineering or technical program at a four-year college or university for the 2023-2024 school year, and
- is a U.S. citizen.

B. Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- grade point average
- internship/co-op experience and community involvement,
- answers to the question(s) on the application.

C. Required Application Materials

Applications must include the following:

- a completed application,
- a complete transcript of the high school grades,

D. Other

- Applications must be received by March 10th, 2023.
- All applicants will be notified of the final selection by March 31st, 2023.
