TOM EICKELSCHULTE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Optimist Club of Quincy Scholarship Committee annually in April selects two (2) recipients from among eligible applicants completing applications to receive these \$1,500.00 scholarship awards.

- A. Applicants must be students in good standing at the QAVTC for at least one academic year.
- B. Applicants must be students graduating from a high school served by the Quincy Area Vocational Technical Center upon completion of a professional prep or vocational-technical program of study at the QAVTC.

The Scholarship Committee utilizes written applications and personal interviews of the top applicants to determine scholarship recipients.

- A. Applicants are divided into "professional" (4 year college) and "occupational" (2 year college/tech school) groups based on their choices of post- secondary educational institutions and specializations.
- B. Applicants are then judged against others in the same group on five criteria.
 - Academic ability (GPA, grades in specialization, class rank, SAT score)
 - Attitude (attendance, work ethic, classroom behavior)
 - Character (citizenship, community service, school involvement)
 - Conduct in the interview (poise, forthrightness, ability to communicate)
 - Financial need (financial aid, family resources, educational savings, work)
- C. Applicants must submit a copy of their letter of application to attend, or a letter of acceptance, by an accredited college, community college, vocational or technical training school in their scholarship applications (four-year college major must be within a recognized vocational or technical area of study which requires a bachelor's degree).
- D. Applicants awarded the scholarships will be honored at an Optimist Club meeting and will receive a certificate of scholarship at his or her school's annual Awards Night.
- E. Payment of benefits is made directly to the Eickelschulte Scholar's college, training institution or technical school upon receipt of an acceptable notification of enrollment from the institution.
 - 1. Scholars must be enrolled at the college or institution and in the instructional program specified in the Eickelschulte Scholarship Application by and the scholarship must be claimed by March 15th of the calendar year following selection as an award recipient to avoid risk of losing this scholarship.
 - 2. The committee must be contacted by October 1 if the scholar is not enrolling for fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
