### **SBMEF Impact Scholarship**

#### **Candidate Eligibility Requirements**

- A female U.S. citizen.
- Has achieved a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better.
- Plans to attend John Wood Community College for the 2022/2023 academic year.
- Will be a freshman or sophomore in August 2022

#### **Guidelines for the Impact Scholarship**

- This is a \$1000 Impact Scholarship awarded to an individual who plans to attend John Wood Community College for the 2022/2023 academic year.
- The application deadline is May 15<sup>th</sup> 2022. One recipient will be selected in July 2022.
- Completing the application does not guarantee a scholarship will be awarded.

#### **Procedures**

To complete the online application, the student will need to:

- Agree to the eligibility requirements.
- Complete the online application form.
- Write a biographical sketch that includes describing the following:
  - Future plans including academic interests, career interests and highest degree she intends to earn.
  - Academic information including GPA and any academic distinctions or honors.
  - Extracurricular activities and work experience highlighting the most important extracurricular, volunteer and work activities.
- Upload three (3) professional letters of reference dated the same year as the application.
